Minutes

Call to Order: by Chair LeBeau at 6:36 PM.

Minutes: The October minutes were unanimously approved with a motion from Adam and a second from Jenn.

Public Comment: There were no public comments.

Council/RCAB Update: NA.

Staff Update: Tony covered the passage of the PAYT ordinance and next steps, the Sustainability Plan, the green building ordinances, and recovery from the cyber-attack.

Plans and Projects for 2021: The committee began discussion of possible plans and projects for 2021. Among the options discussed were a solid waste plan, education on waste diversion for lower income communities, school related initiatives (possibly Renew our Schools), neighborhood programs, and life-cycle responsibility legislation.
