**Public Art Committee Meeting  
July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021**

**I. OPENING OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING**

**Call to Order**

The July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021, meeting of the Public Art Committee was called to order at 7:01 pm. The meeting was conducted via electronic participation due to the presence of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in Colorado and subsequent Safer at Home Executive Order from Governor Jared Polis.

**Roll Call**

Those in attendance from the Public Art Committee were Committee Chair Barbara Rudlaff, Committee Vice Chair Lindsey Wohlman, Treasurer Bea Glassford, Secretary Edie Johansen, Members Heather Bair, Josie Knapp, Pamela Sherrick, and LCAC Liaison Marissa Aguilera Saints.

The City of Lafayette Public Art Coordinator Stacey Bernstein was also present.

**II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

*A motion was made by Pamela Sherrick and seconded by Marissa Aguilera Saints to approve the minutes from the June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Public Art Committee meeting. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.*

**III. PUBLIC INPUT**

There was no Public Input.

**IV. AGENDA ITEMS**

**A. Reinstate Josie Knapp to PAC**

*A motion was made by Lindsey Wohlman and seconded by Bea Glassford to reinstate Josie Knapp to PAC for another term. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.*

**B. See & Respond! Volunteer Sign-up**

Stacey Bernstein presented this item. She advised the Committee of volunteer opportunities for the event on October 16<sup>th</sup> at the Lafayette Library. PAC members volunteered for the event tasks. She will update the Committee of any additional volunteer opportunities closer to the date.

**C. Update on Public Art Grant Projects**

Stacey Bernstein presented this item. Updates as follows:

Jessica Manzanares has finished the "Through Our Eyes" mural. While she was working on the project, community members brought family photos to be added to the piece; and she was able to curate a few additional photos into the piece. This mural was featured on 9 News in Colorado.

The Wilson Community Gardens shed has murals of flowers completed on two sides of the shed. The shed is viewable as you drive west on Emma Street from Public Road.

The Sanchez Community Garden project is on hold until school resumes, and more of the families are back after summer and able to participate in the painting of the mural.

Diversity Mural at Centaurus High School was scheduled to have the wood repaired and the mural design updated and painted. However, a group of youth with the Lafayette Empowerment Center simply repainted the old mural, independent of what was planned with the PAC Grant. So, the artist has returned the grant funds to be held in 'escrow' until 2022 when it will be distributed for the project as originally planned.

No update on the Alley Art Amazin' or Youth Mural Mentorship projects at this time.

The mural at Elizabeth's Embellishments has not started yet.

#### D. AMPA Update

Stacey Bernstein presented this item. AMPA has completed and submitted the assessment and treatment plan for of all City of Lafayette outdoor sculptures in the Permanent Collection. Some of the pieces that require immediate treatment are *Banned* at the Rec Center, *Flower of Life*, *Lady in Waiting*, and *The Watchers*. ACRD will request that all bronzes be cleaned and hot waxed to start them all on the same cycle of maintenance.

#### E. ARTS!Lafayette Report

Heather Bair presented this item. She advised that the nonprofit Board did not meet last month.

#### F. Report from LCAC

Marissa Aguilera Saints presented this item. She advised the PAC that LCAC met in June and welcomed three new board members. LCAC has one Arts Outside event scheduled for July 22, a Nature Photography session with Jerry Morrell and Martin Ogle. Attendance is limited, but there are still a few openings. The Commission is currently receiving NEA Cares grant reports. Crystal Polis, who was hired to manage the NEA Cares Grant process, is reviewing all final reports to ensure they meet federal requirements. Stacey Bernstein informed the Committee that the LCAC Arts in Community Grant call for submissions will open July 19, 2021, and close in early September.

#### G. ACRD Directors Report

Stacey Bernstein presented this item on behalf of Susan Booker. She advised the PAC that Barbara Rudlaff has resigned as Chair of PAC. This opens two positions on the Committee; so, she encouraged the Committee to recruit new members. In August, PAC will vote for a new Chair.

#### H. City Council Liaison Report

JD Mangat was not present.

**V. ADJOURN**

A motion was made by Barbara Rudlaff, that was seconded by Pamela Sherrick, to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 p.m. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.
