

**SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF LAFAYETTE, COLORADO**

**City Council Workshop
With Planning Commission and the Community Advisory Committee
October 11, 2021**

Opening of Workshop

The October 11, 2021 workshop of the Lafayette City Council was called to order at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers at Lafayette City Hall, 1290 S. Public Road, Lafayette, Colorado. This was a joint workshop with the Lafayette Planning Commission and the Comprehensive Plan Community Advisory Committee and a continuation of the conversation started at the workshop on September 27, 2021.

Those in attendance in Council Chambers included Mayor Jamie Harkins, Mayor Pro Tem Stephanie Walton, and Councilors Tim Barnes, Tonya Briggs, JD Mangat, and Brian Wong. Councilor Chelsea Behanna was absent. Participants from the Planning Commission included Chair Darcia Thomas, Vice Chair Joseph Smith, and Commissioners Alison Fischer, Frank Phillips, Nicole Samson, Michelle Stephens, and Bill Watson. Participants from the Community Advisory Committee included Adam Gianola, Dave Heinrich, and Karen Norback.

Also present were Deputy City Administrator Kady Doelling, City Clerk Lynnette Beck, Planning and Building Director Jeff Brasel, Principal Planner Phil Kleisler, and Britt Palmberg from Rick Engineering.

Comprehensive Plan

Director Brasel introduced new staff in the Planning and Building Department: Linda Lee, Planning and Building Permit Technician; Michael Stitt, Senior Building Plans Examiner and Inspector; Millissa Berry, Senior Planner; and Phil Kleisler, Principal Planner.

At the September 27, 2021 workshop, Director Brasel explained that comments received on the comprehensive plan had been classified into three categories: (1) no change needed, (2) incorporate into the final plan, and (3) needs discussion. He led a group dialogue around the items classified as needing discussion. The workshop ended before the group could complete the discussion items, and a second session was scheduled for October 11, 2021.

Director Brasel continued the conversation around the comments identified as needing discussion, explaining that Discussion feedback would be used to inform subsequent drafts of the plan. Participants were encouraged to consult the packet materials to follow the discussion.
