**Public Art Committee Meeting  
October 13, 2021**

**I. OPENING OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING**

**Call to Order**

The October 13, 2021, meeting of the Public Art Committee was called to order at 6:08 pm. The meeting was conducted at The Collective, 201 N. Public Road, Lafayette, CO 80026.

**Roll Call**

Those in attendance from the Public Art Committee were Chair Lindsey Wohlman, Vice-Chair Josie Knapp, Secretary Edie Johansen, and LCAC Liaison Marissa Aguilera Saints. Treasurer Pamela Sherrick was absent.

City participants included ACRD Director and Staff Liaison Susan Booker, Public Art Coordinator Stacey Bernstein, and City Council Liaison JD Mangat.

**II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion was made by Lindsey Wohlman and seconded by Josie Knapp to approve the minutes from the September 15, 2021, Public Art Committee meeting. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.

**III. PUBLIC INPUT**

There was no Public Input.

**IV. AGENDA ITEMS**

**A. PAC Applicant Interviews**

Lindsey Wohlman facilitated PAC interviewing 2 candidates for open positions. Ellen Smith an 11-year resident of Lafayette, and Daniel Guley a 3-year resident of Lafayette. All PAC members present asked multiple questions of the applicants.

A motion was made by Lindsey Wohlman and seconded by Josie Knapp to recommend to City Council that they appoint Ellen Smith and Daniel Guley for full membership to the Public Art Committee. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.

**B. Human Rights Commission Presentation to PAC.**

HRC Chair Elizabeth Lichtenstein and City Liaison and Library Director Melissa Hisel presented the outcomes of their committee's work and supplied many materials and recordings to review. They advised PAC what public art pieces have come up for review due to community concerns, asked PAC to reflect on any concerns and plan to prepare a report to City Council with their own recommendations about the implementation of HRC's recommendations in regard to public art. HRC has been working on their recommendation for over a year and it is understood that PAC may need to take a few months to come to a consensus or near consensus.

**C. See & Respond Update**

Stacey Bernstein presented this item. She requested additional volunteers from PAC to support this event for the City and some members volunteered.

**D. ARTS!Lafayette Report**

Stacey Bernstein presented this item. She advised that ARTS!Lafayette interviewed one board candidate and is still seeking new membership. She also discussed the ARTS!Lafayette budget and that internal funding requests for 2022 are in process.

**E. Report from LCAC**

Marissa Aguilera Saints presented this item. She advised that LCAC still has one alternate position available. LCAC is still receiving positive feedback from the retreat where they reviewed the LCAC Mission and City of Lafayette Guidelines. LCAC is reviewing applications for the Arts & Community grant funding cycle that recently closed, a subcommittee is reviewing the applications.

**F. ACRD Directors Report**

Susan Booker presented this item. She advised that City employees are busy working on end of year appraisals, 2022-2023 exhibit plans. She advised that the City Council has adopted the 2022 budget.

**G. City Council Liaison Report**

JD Mangat presented this item. He advised that the City Council was happy that HRC had started to roll out their work and have conversations with other City Boards and Commissions. He reminded PAC that 2021 was an election year for some members of Council.
