**I. OPENING OF REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING**

**Call to Order**

The March 2, 2022 meeting of Lafayette Youth Advisory Commission was called to order at 6:30 pm.

**II. COMMITTEE MINUTES**

**IV. AGENDA ITEMS**

**A. Muse Community Studio Program**

Co-Chair Andrea Lastiri-Montiel reintroduced Education Consultant Kristen Davidson, who is supporting the development of a new music production workshop for Lafayette 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> graders. Returning to their previous conversation, members shared recommendations regarding recruitment and outreach.

**B. Partnerships & Ordinance Review**

Program Director Elaina Verveer presented this item. Elaina shared a proposal that LYAC had received from Boulder County Public Health regarding Lafayette Ordinance 40, which seeks to reduce the youth consumption of sugary beverages. Referred to LYAC by Mayor Mangat, Boulder County Public Health specifically asked that LYAC work with Council to amend the ordinance. Additional information and language recently adopted by the Longmont City Council, which passed a similar ordinance, will be provided for members' review on April 6.

Elaina also discussed the Commission's continued partnership with Lafayette Communities That Care and related deliverables.

**C. 2022 Cesar Chavez Celebration**

Co-Chair Josie Briggs presented this item. Josie confirmed the Commission's participation in an event for local K-6 students. Scheduled to be held on Saturday, April 2 from 1-5 pm at the Lafayette Public Library, the event will serve to celebrate Cesar Chavez, Dolores Huerta, and other civil rights activists.

*A motion was made by Matthew Hinojosa and seconded by Wyatt Lunz to allocate up to \$1,000 for refreshments and supplies related to Lafayette's annual Cesar Chavez Celebration on April 2. The motion passed unanimously.*

**D. Mental Health Focus Groups & Parent Workshop**

Co-Chair Josie Briggs reviewed dates for upcoming events, including a series of mental health focus groups and a parent workshop. A facilitation training was scheduled for members to prepare for these events.

**E. Sub-Committee Meetings & Action Items**

LYAC members briefly met in their respective sub-committees. Members of the mental health sub-committee shared their work and perspective on the topic with visiting CU Boulder students.

**V. STAFF REPORT**

Staff Liaison Kelsey Thompson discussed requirements related to using Signal messaging, responding to an earlier inquiry.

None.


**VII. ADJOURN**
