RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, COLORADO
ESTABLISHING A WASTE REDUCTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Lafayette has established a goal to minimize waste generated in Lafayette through recycling, reuse and pollution prevention, and to properly manage the waste streams that are generated in Lafayette, by the city, its businesses, and its resident; and

Whereas, the City council wishes to establish a waste reduction advisory committee to advise it in matters relating to waste reduction; and

Whereas, the City Council wishes to create a Waste Reduction Advisory committee and establish parameters within which the Committee should function.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Lafayette, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1. Creation of Committee

Pursuant to Sections 4.13 and 5.1 of the Lafayette Charter there is hereby established the “Lafayette Waste Reduction Advisory Committee,” for the purposes stated in this resolution. The Lafayette Waste Reduction Advisory Committee may be referred to in this resolution as the “Committee.”

Section 2. Purpose of Committee

The Committee is being created to serve solely in an advisory capacity, and to make recommendations to the City Council on the following matters:

A. To examine the needs of the City for waste reduction activities that are not already in place and to assess the need for enhancement of current waste reduction programs;

B. To assist the City Council in establishing priorities for the implementation of waste reduction activities, funds permitting; and

C. To examine and make recommendations to the Council with respect to possible sources of funding for the implementation of waste reduction activities.

Section 3. Composition of Committee: Compensation

The committee shall serve without pay and shall consist of seven members, each of whom have been a resident of the City for at least one year immediately prior to the day of appointment and shall be a qualified and registered elector of the City. The City Council shall appoint each of the members. The City Administrator shall appoint staff to support the Committee.

Section 4. Intent of Appointments

It is the intent of the City Council to make appointments to the Committee among citizens in the community representing differing geographic areas and constituencies, in an effort to bring a balance to the Committee, to enable it to make recommendations to the City Council after considering the needs of the City as a whole.

Section 5. Term

The City council shall initially appoint four members to four year terms, and three members to two year terms. Upon the expiration of each Committee members' initial term of office, each Committee member shall sera a four year term.

Section 6. Vacancies

In the event that any Committee member ceases to be qualified to serve on the Committee, or resigns therefrom, the City Council shall appoint a new member, in the same manner as the previous member was appointed.
