



Lafayette Municipal Court Approved Community Service

Community service can be completed at a nonprofit organization such as a church, senior center, school, animal shelter, library, food bank, etc. You cannot get paid for any of the work that you do. The court is not responsible for any injuries or damages, nor will the court provide any type of insurance coverage. Listed below are some possible ways to complete community service. You do not have to pick one these locations/organizations.

When calling identify yourself as someone who needs to complete **court ordered community service**. When you go remember to take a photo ID and your paperwork with you.
