**Are you a Boulder County renter struggling to cover housing costs due to COVID-19? This program can help if you are:**

- 1** Unable to pay rent because your household has been financially impacted by COVID-19; and
- 2** At risk of homelessness or housing instability; and
- 3** Not currently receiving - or have not applied to receive - rental assistance for the same period requested; and
- 4** In a household with a gross monthly income that is at or below the maximum income limit for the program
