 Water Supply from two Reservoirs 3/4 Mile N.W. of City. Reservoirs have a Combined Area of Twenty Acres and have an Elevation of 100 Above City Grade at Intersection of Simpson St. and Ave. B. Reservoirs Fed by 1000' 4" Wooden Pipe Conduits Water from Reservoirs to City Limits. About 3/4 Mile 4" Wooden Water Pipes in City Limits. Gravity Pressure Domestic a Pipe of 40 Lbs. Pressure Per Sq. In. Water Pipes for all of Wood and are laid to lie in open condition. Pipes Laid in 1888 - 16 In. and 8 Single Hydrants. While no definite Steps Have been Taken the City is Considering the Construction of an entirely New System of Water Works.

FIRE DEPT. Volunteer - 25 Men - 2 Independent Horse Carts - 1000' 21" Hose in Poor Condition - (Rovio) by Bell of Horse House. - No Paved Streets - Grades have about 2% Declination from West to East. Public Lights Electric - No Fire Lamps.
